#### AsCNP-ASEAN Congress

The 1<sup>st</sup> AsCNP-ASEAN International Congress was successfully held in Yogyakarta, Indonesia, from February 28 to March 2, 2019, under the tremendous leadership of Prof. Andi J. Tanra and Prof. Sonny Lisal. A total of 50 oral sessions were held, with 124 speakers and nearly 500 participants. Photo 1 shows the Opening Ceremony. It was a great honor for me to announce the opening of the congress by ringing the gong. Photo 2 shows one of the lecture halls full of participants. I sincerely appreciate all of the participants, organizers, sponsors, and hospitality of the Indonesian people who made this such a wonderful congress.

#### AsCNP Board Meeting

The board meeting was held on February 28 (Photo 3). The AsCNP Board approved the budget for this year and organized the Award Committee (Chair: Prof. Shih-Ku Lin) and Education Committee (Chair: Prof. Andi J. Tanra). Dr. Gavin T. Dawe introduced the 7<sup>th</sup> AsCNP meeting that will be held in Singapore in 2021. The Award Committee will soon announce the call for award applications.

#### 6th AsCNP Congress

This congress will be held in Fukuoka, Japan, from October 11 to 13, 2019: <https://www2.aeplan.co.jp/ascnp/index.html>. The deadline for Early Bird Registration is April 30. The deadline for abstract submission is May 31. Three Plenary Lectures, two Special Lectures, and approximately 60 Symposia have been organized for the 6th AsCNP Congress. On October 10, the Preopening Gathering (free for AsCNP2019 participants) will be held at the venue from 5:00 PM to 7:30 PM. On October 13, the Closing Ceremony with an Award Ceremony and Farewell Party will begin at 6:30 PM. I hope most of you can make your hotel reservations from October 10 to 14 and participate in the entire congress. I have learned that available hotels in the Fukuoka area during the congress are becoming difficult to find, likely because of the Rugby World Cup that will also be held Fukuoka on October 12. The AsCNP 2019 organizers asked a travel agency to block several hundred hotel rooms in Fukuoka.
